

What is the Gospel?


- According to Paul in his letter to the Galatians?
 - Statement: Justification by Faith
 - Reference: Galatians 3:6-8
 - Gospel in the OT: Genesis 12:3, 15:6
 - Focus: Cross of Christ => Curse of the Law
- According to Paul in his letter to the Ephesians?
 - Statement: Union with Christ
 - Reference: Ephesians 5:31-32
 - Gospel in the OT: Genesis 2:24
 - Focus: Exaltation of Christ => Cosmic reconciliation

And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." (Galatians 3:8)

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." ³² This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. (Ephesians 5:31-32)

• Don't be surprised to see the gospel in OT because the gospel came before the law! Rather you should expect it!

Covenant and the Law

• Thesis: Abrahamic Covenant 3:6-9 Eternal

• Parenthesis: Mosaic Law 3:19-27 Temporary

• Essence: Love 2:20, 5:14 Eternal

• Illustration:

- Traffic laws
 -> Mosaic Law
- Christ's Bank of Heaven -> Salvation
- Drive by the Spirit -> Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness,

goodness, faithfulness, gentleness,

self-control

Theme: Incorporation Into Christ

- The Great Exchange / Substitution
 - Curse: Christ redeemed us from the curse of the by become a curse for us (3:13)
 - Blessing: in Christ Jesus the **blessing** of Abraham might come to the Gentiles (3:14)
- Adoption in Christ
 - For in Christ Jesus you are **sons of God** (3:26)
 - God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" (4:6)
 - Now you, brothers, like **Isaac**, are **children** of promise (4:28)
- Baptism (not circumcision)
 - As many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ (3:27)
 - (Col 2:11-12)

Theme: Cross of Christ

- Historicity of the Cross
 - It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified (3:2)
- Significance of the Cross
 - Christ redeemed us from the law by becoming a curse (3:13)
 - For it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree" (3:13)
- Union with Christ on the Cross
 - I have been crucified with Christ (2:2)
 - By the cross the world is **crucified** to me (6:14)
 - By the cross I am **crucified** to the world (6:14)
 - All who belong to Christ have crucified the flesh (5:24)
 - I boast in the **cross** of our Lord Jesus Christ (6:14)
- Offense of the Cross (5:11)
 - that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ (6:12)
 - I bear on my body the marks (stigmata) of Jesus (6:17)

Theme: Spirit

- Coming of the Spirit
 - Spirit is received by faith (3:2)
 - We begin and continue in Christ by the Spirit (3:2)
 - God supplies the Spirit (3:5)
 - God promised the Spirit the blessing of Abraham (3:14)
- Nature of the Spirit
 - Spirit is of sonship, Spirit of God's Son, crying "Abba! Father!" (4:6)
- Battle of the Spirit
 - Children of the Spirit are persecuted by the children of flesh (4:29)
 - Spirit and **flesh** are opposed to each other (5:16-17)
 - If you are led by the Spirit you are not under the **law** (5:18)
- Fruit of the Spirit
 - Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, self-control (5:22-23)
- Telos of the Spirit
 - Spirit leads to eternal life (6:8)
