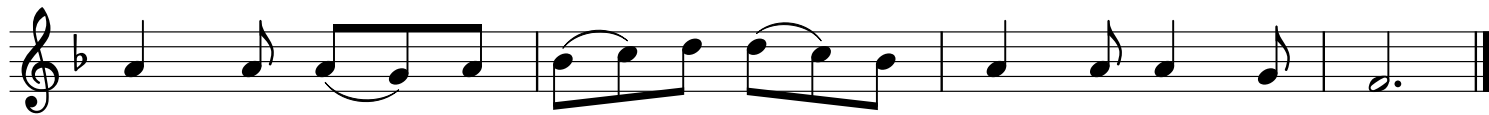
1. I was a wand - 'ring sheep, I did not love__ the fold; I
