

Confession | Joel 2:12-13, Psalm 51:1-12 & Trisagion

"Yet even now," declares the LORD, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning, and rend your hearts and not your garments."

Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and he relents over disaster.




